
The Online Library has purchased several core text books in electronic format, and the collection is constantly growing. Please note that not all your required textbooks can be provided but we consider all your suggestions.


Access Abi/Inform e-books by selecting the Advanced Search tab

Select Source type: Books (1) - click search,



Access by logging in at <http://search.ebscohost.com>, then select 'EBSCO host web' from the list of databases, and then choose **eBook Collection** from the list. Within the collection click the eBooks link in the top toolbar

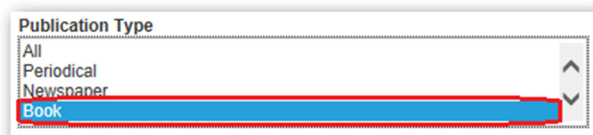

Log in from the database list on your course gateway. If the database is not listed on your gateway go to- <http://search.ebscohost.com> selecting ‘EBSCO host web’ from the above link, then choose PsycBooks from the list.

From the American Psychological Association (APA) **PsycBooks** includes over 38,000 chapters in PDF from over 2,500 books, It also contains over 1,600 classic books of landmark historical impact in psychology dating from the 1600s.
