Use the drop down menu to select whether you want to search by all headings, Title, Author or Publisher. This example shows a search by Title.

The book you want should appear near the top of the search results. If you cannot see the book make sure that 'Show unowned content' under the **Library Availability** heading is **unchecked** as this will narrow the search to show books that you have full access to.

Click on the title to access the text.

To save a book to your **favourites** click on the star symbol, this will save the book to the area '**My Bookshelf**' so you can easily access it next time to log in to the Dawsons database.





Click on the book image to read the text online. You can also copy and print a limited amount of the text. This is usually 5% but it depends on the guidelines put in place by the publisher.



Click on the download button to read the text offline. You will be offered the option to download it for between 1 and 7 days.
