The Online Library has a growing collection of E-books in the Dawsons E-Book Collection.

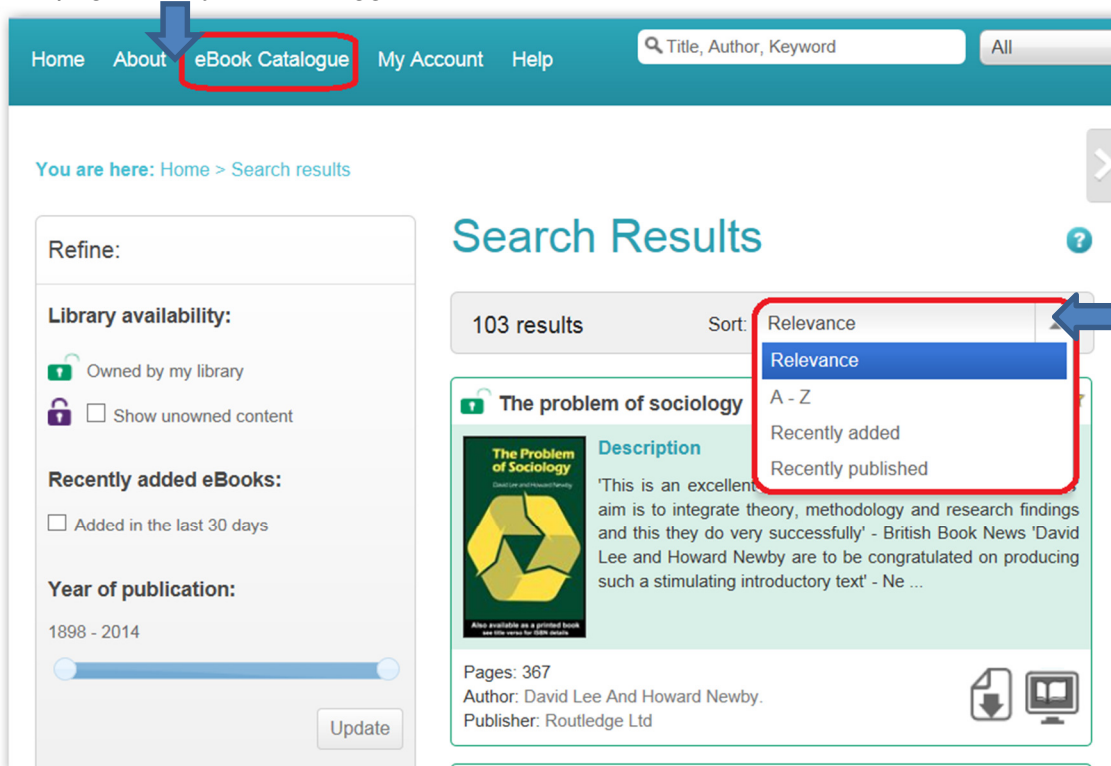
Access the Dawson E-book Collection with your **Athens account**:

You will be able to read or download the full text of all the E-books in the database that we have a subscription to. If we have not subscribed to a book you can usually view a five minute preview.

Browsing our collection

To view all the full text e-books that we have subscribed to select the **eBook Catalogue tab** from the homepage once you have logged in.

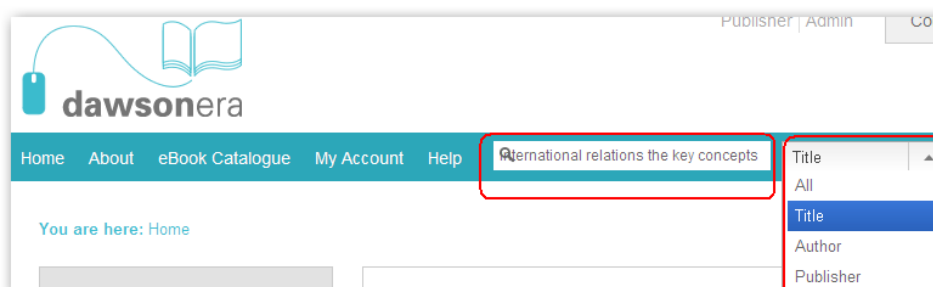


You can display the books in order of relevance, by A-Z and by what has been recently added or published.

Finding a book in your reading list

If one of your course textbooks is available in the Dawsons E-book collection you can use the Quick Search to find it.

Use the drop down menu to select whether you want to search by all headings, Title, Author or Publisher. This example shows a search by Title.

The book you want should appear near the top of the search results. If you cannot see the book make sure that 'Show unowned content' under the **Library Availability** heading is **unchecked** as this will narrow the search to show books that you have full access to.

Click on the title to access the text.

To save a book to your **favourites** click on the star symbol, this will save the book to the area **'My Bookshelf'** so you can easily access it next time to log in to the Dawsons database.
