




Enter any term or phrase into the basic search box and Justis will search across all the sources the University subscribes to in Justis, i.e. cases and legislation. When searching for phrases, be sure to put quotations around the phrase you're searching for, e.g. "strict liability".



If your search returns more than one document, you will be taken to the Results screen. Simply click on the title of the case or legislation you wish to view.

If your first search returns more results than you need, you can narrow it down using the resource type filters on the left side of the screen. For example, refine your results to display only cases.

Select **Source Filter** on the left side of the screen to narrow the search by source e.g. choose the Times Law Reports.



This narrows the results for "strict liability" from 13887 to 163. You may then want to narrow it further, for instance by searching for a further subject term using the **Text Filter**, e.g. crime. You then have 11 results to view.
