- The Basic search box is located at the top of the home page.
- If you know the details of the newspaper article you require, type the title into the basic search box putting quotation marks around the text to search as a phrase.

For example:

European Newsstream

"Bank of England to pump more money into financial system"	Q

• Or search for articles on a topic. For example:



- Using quotation marks searches for the **exact phrase** within the article. "Total quality management" is therefore a more precise search than for total quality management, which would retrieve articles with the words present individually.
- A tick box under the search box enable you to limit your search to full text.

## **The Search Results**



Select

'Modify

'Narrow results by' menu refines your search results.
Full text: only displays the results where the full text is available.
Source type: refine your search to newspapers, trade journals or magazines.
Publication date:

Narrows results to a specific date or date range.
