

In the **Top Navigation Bar**, you can browse for content by Topics, via the Search Bar and even find custom created expert playlists.


Under the **Start Learning Menu**, you can select courses, which are curated by job role or skill sets. You can also refine your search by format such as courses, Live Events, Interactive or books.


You can also save what you find in a new or existing playlist.



Reading a book in O'Reilly

To open a book inside of O'REILLY, you can click on the item. If you follow the arrows to the right, the first one will show the contents of the book, where you can choose what to read. The second one allows you to choose whatever style is most accessible for your reading needs (as exhibited in third image).
