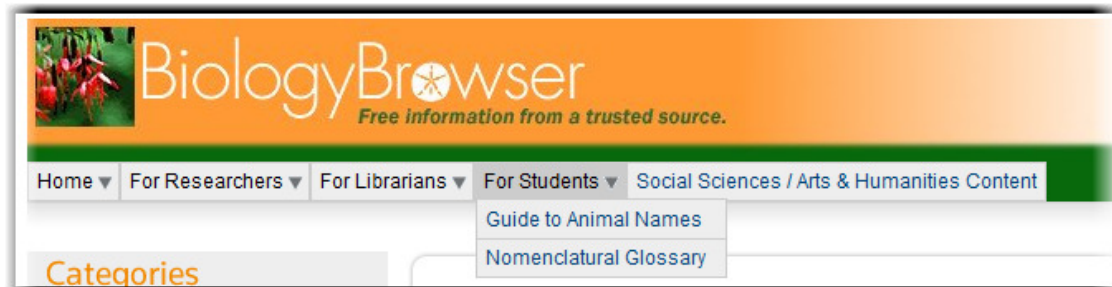
After you have done a search, you will see a page like the one above. Click on the title of an item to see more details.

You can filter by topic by clicking on one of the categories on the right side of the page. The numbers in brackets are the number of items relevant to that topic. In this example, there are 193 items relevant to both medicine and the USA. Click **Show more** to see more topics you can choose from.

You can also filter by what type of resource by clicking one of the categories under **Filter by Resource**.

The Nomenclatural Glossary for Zoology is an alphabetical list of words and technical terms with explanations on what they mean. Click on one of the letters at the top of the page to be taken to words beginning with that letter.
