You can select some of the databases you want to search across. Tick the boxes next to the databases you want to search across, and then use the search box at the top of the page.

However, because the materials in Gale are so diverse, you cannot search across all of the databases in one search. The databases at the bottom of the page are not cross-searchable. This means that if you are looking for a specific type of material, it might be a good idea to look at the database descriptions and then search within the individual databases which look promising.

There are other useful filters on the right side of the page you can use, such as limiting by full text and publication date.

If the full text is available, you will see a 'Download PDF' button underneath the search result.
