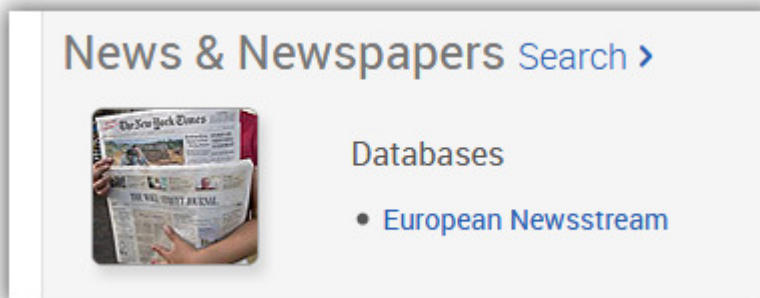

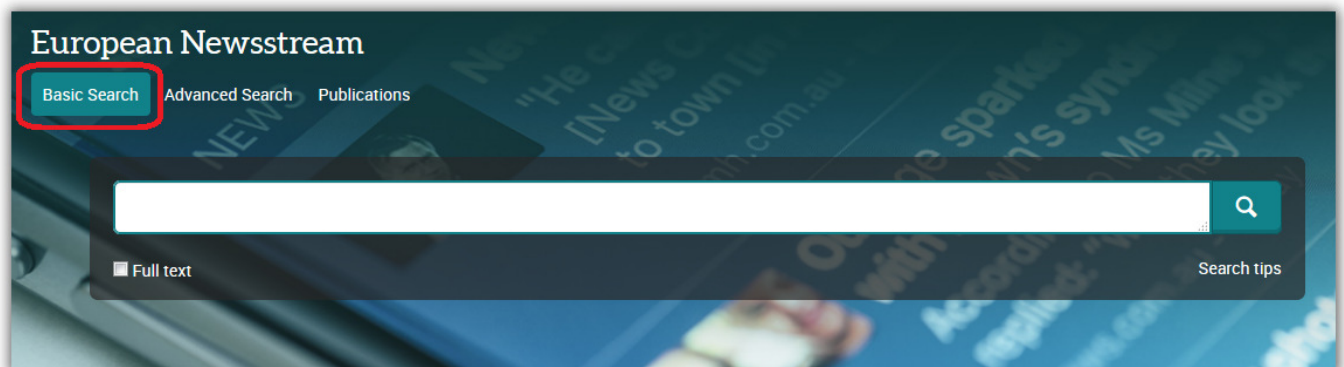

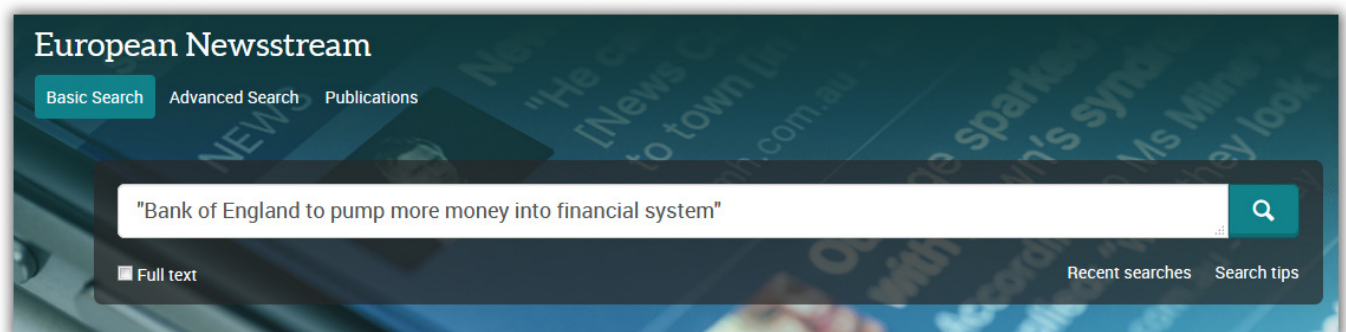


Basic Search

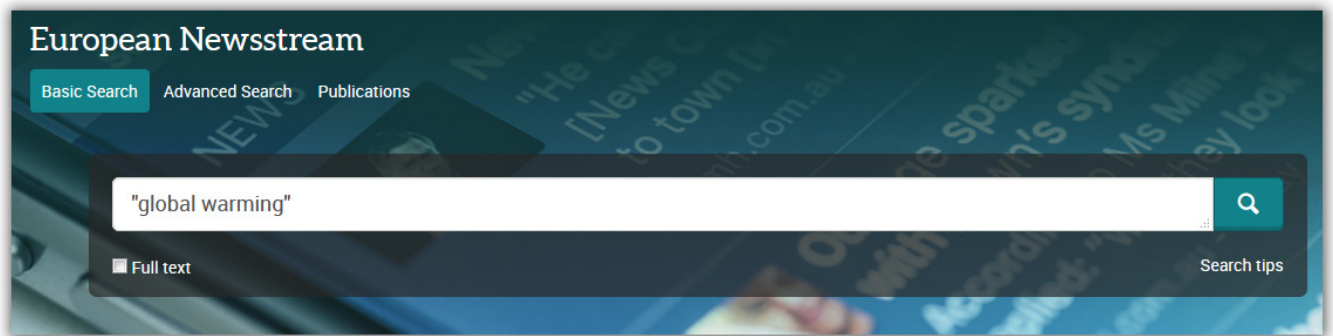


- The Basic search box is located at the top of the home page.
- If you know the details of the newspaper article you require, type the title into the basic search box putting quotation marks around the text to search as a phrase.

For example:



- Or search for articles on a topic. For example:



- Using quotation marks searches for the **exact phrase** within the article. "Total quality management" is therefore a more precise search than for total quality management, which would retrieve articles with the words present individually.
- A tick box under the search box enable you to limit your search to fulltext.

Select 'Preview' to view the article abstract.

'Narrow results by' menu refines your search results.

Full text: only displays the results where the full text is available.

Source type: refine your search to newspapers, trade journals or magazines.

Publication date: Narrows results to a specific date or date range.

Select the publications tab to view an A-Z list of the newspapers in the database, or to search for a particular newspaper. Select the publication name to discover its **full text** coverage and to browse or search all the available papers.
